FORESTERS FOOTBALL CLUB – PARENTAL CONSENT INFORMATION AND KIT POLICY

PHOTOGRAPHS OF MEMBERS - From time to time Foresters FC officials, managers and coaches may wish to take individual photographs and/or video shots of your child whilst playing for or training with the club. Any images taken will be strictly for club records, PR and promotional purposes, or to benefit training sessions. You have the right to access these images at any time upon request.

DATA OF MEMBERS - The information contained within this document and the application to join the club are held by the club in both hard and soft format. This information will not be given out to any other organization or individual without your consent. You have the right to access this information at any time. All membership forms are shredded within 3 months of the end of the season to which they apply and soft records deleted from the database.

EMERGENCY FIRST AID – From time to time club officials, managers or coaches may need to give emergency first aid to your child whilst playing for or training with the club. All managers and coaches are required to attend first aid courses whilst involved with the club. Where possible, parental consent will be obtained before any first aid is administered, however this may not always be possible.

PARENTAL SUPPORT/VOLUNTEERING – Foresters is run entirely by volunteers for the benefit of its members. We are always looking for more willing volunteers to become involved to ensure the club continues to deliver on its mission of providing football for all. In return for your support the club operates a discount structure to its fees, which is explained in more detail on the front of this membership form. If you feel that you are able to offer support and help to the club in any capacity please indicate when filling out the membership form online.

CLUB KIT POLICY - All players participating in official leagues will be provided with a club football strip. This strip can only be worn when training or playing matches for the club. The cost of any loss or damage to the football strip, unless when training or playing matches must be paid by the player or their parent/guardian. All kit provided either directly by the club or through sponsorship unless otherwise expressly agreed by the Club Chairman will remain the property of the club at all times.

IT IS A CONDITION OF MEMBERSHIP THAT YOU AGREE TO KEEP THE KIT PROVIDED IN GOOD CONDITION AND RETURN TO THE CLUB UPON LEAVING OR WHEN REQUESTED AND IN ADDITION PAY FOR ANY REPLACEMENT IN CIRCUMSTANCES AS DESCRIBED ABOVE.
